

## Special Requirements. Academic Programs for mobility students.

1. The students interested in applying for a mobility stay can find the academic programs available in the corresponding link.
  2. To qualify as mobility students, the applicants must have at least a 44% of credits covered in the university of origin, as well as having a minimum average of 8.5 or its equivalent.
  3. To present a letter exposing their motives in Spanish (600 words maximum), which must include the academic contribution of the subjects selected to their formation.
  4. In the case of not being a Spanish native speaker, a B2 certification based on the Common European Framework of Reference or its equivalent issued by any official institution recognized internationally is required.
  5. Those who want to take subjects of any Program in the Colegio de Letras Modernas (Modern Literatures School), a B2 certification based on the Common European Framework of Reference or its equivalent issued by any official institution recognized internationally of the corresponding language is required as well.
  6. The maximum number of mobility students accepted by program is 5.
  7. It is possible to be enrolled in a maximum of 5 subjects in only one program.
  8. Every enrollment will be subject to availability of each class, therefore, there might be modifications to the original application.
  9. If it were necessary, an interview in the corresponding School will be programmed as part of the admission process.
10. The students have the right to modify their enrollment only once and exclusively during the modifications week.
11. If an acceptance letter for two consecutive semesters is required, the acceptance to the second semester will be subject to the academic performance of the student in the first semester.
12. The student must fill in the form placed in the Faculty's website. Spring Semester 2021 (February to June), corresponding to subjects of PAIR semesters (See the Faculty calendar). Fall Semester 2021 (August to November), corresponding to IMPAIR semesters (See the Faculty calendar).
